## **AGENDA**

1. Final decision on mode of recognition for Distinguished Schools (<u>please</u> review the Options & Prices Spreadsheet)

Mike presented the options and prices to the Committee. Members discussed preferences and possibilities, keeping within the \$10,000.00 budgeted for these expenses. Consensus was to do the following:

- No to plaques
- No to certificates
- Yes to 3' X 5' Banners B2 Personalized Price: \$32 each (\$3200 per 100)
- Yes to Professional Group Photographer: \$1500
- Yes to 3-month subscription to Title I On Demand: \$39 each (\$3900 per 100)

Excluding postage, shipping, handling, etc., the total comes to \$8600 for 2015.

## 2. Update on audio documentaries (Mike)

Mike and his daughter (Heather—a Chicago resident and a PBS-trained documentarian) are working on a pilot audio podcast of the success story of a Title I Distinguished School. The effort is being coordinated with Melina Wright (IL) and one of Illinois' Title I schools. Heather has volunteered to go to the Chicago area school, conduct and video-tape the interviews (principal, staff, and students), do the editing, and add an "intro" and "outro"— in order to create an example of what an audio podcast could be. When completed, the podcast will be posted in the Committee files pages for members to access and review. More to come on this one.
