Criteria high performing, close the gap, working with other populations may use any of the three to identify 2 schools.

2. Accountability with Data – Evaluation of Title I Impact

High quality, how can we measure?

What are the standards to measure against?

Are there models of programs that have collected data and shown results? Take those schools that were Title I and now don't receive Title I – and/or like demographics schools Title-non-Title what is the information that could be gathered. What would happen if you didn't receive Title I?

Schoolwide or Targeted – what do the data demonstrate?

Show growth of the students in Title I school – entrance – exit data

Do we have access to an evaluator?

Push the department to use their funds to do an evaluation of Title I.

Determine if the growth is related to Title I – effective teachers – having all of these things in place- what practices impact student success.

Are Title I programs working?

Do we have the data – there are additional data points to add to the CSPR reports. What are the key data elements that can be a "change" factor?

Report card information gives us some of the data.

Look at the data to see if the kids are demonstrating positive achievement movement.

Program evaluation tool of schoolwides (MI) for any school to do their own program evaluation – guides a school through an evaluation process. Found what was and wasn't working. Redirect/redefine the program. We aren't collecting data from the schools using the tool.

How do I evaluate the impact of the funds?

Leadership is important.

Knowing what high quality is – what does it look like? Strategies – what worked and can be replicated in other Title I schools. How much and how were the funds being used??? What impact does it have on the schools when districts maintain Title I funds? What supports at the district level have made a positive impact on student growth? What are ineffective practices, what do they look like? Equitable services the impact on private school students receiving services?

Review 2016 Strategic Plan for next steps.
